

**RESIDENT RATEPAYERS  
M.D. OF PROVOST NO. 52  
DUST CONTROL POLICY (Amended Apr. 23/09)**

It is the policy to offer applied calcium chloride or oil as a means of dust control to resident ratepayers at 25% of product cost for the initial application (deadline date of May 15 of each year). Late requests will not be accepted, no exceptions. Applications will be accepted for a minimum distance of 500 feet and up to a maximum of 1000 feet per site.

The applicant recognizes roadways are subject to seasonal weather changes, traffic volume and vehicle weight. Dust controls will be maintained as required at the discretion of the MD of Provost. This impacts the effectiveness and life expectancy of the dust suppressant. Applicants may apply for a second application (of calcium chloride) at the same rate as the initial application (25% of product cost) to be received by July 31 of the same year. Late requests will not be accepted, no exceptions. Note: All Calcium Dust Controls will be bladed in the spring.

The MD will guarantee the dust control will be done in the current year, if the initial application for dust control is received before the deadline of May 15 of each year. The MD also has the right to refuse the application of dust control if so deemed unfeasible after inspection of the site.

The ratepayers acknowledge and agree that the MD makes no guarantee as to the life expectancy of the material process.

Billing will be done after project is completed.
